



Concrete Laborer/Finsisher

This is a traveling position that would be at multiple sites in Illinois

The job tasks may include, but are not limited to loading, unloading, and moving materials from within or near the construction site from pallets, skids, trucks or other locations. May also be asked to move materials to or from storage or work sites to designated areas, using hand trucks, wheelbarrows or other device. Additional tasks could include operating large equipment, this could include bobcats and excavators, selective demolition, concrete placement or flagging. Lifting heavy objects by hand or power hoist and carrying heavy supplies to and from work area. Laborers are also responsible for cleaning work area, machines or other equipment using broom, water hose or blowers, and shoveling or raking loose materials such as dirt, sand and gravel. Will need to be able to pour concrete foundations and have concrete finishing experience.

Responsibilities

- Pouring concrete for sidewalks, sidewalk ramps, curbs, footings and roadway patches.
- Pouring concrete pads for communications buildings
- Shovel concrete, wheel concrete, (via wheelbarrow or other method) and be involved in pours
- Dig trenches for footings and completes fine grading of sand and gravel.
- Perform tasks involving physical labor for building, construction projects, excavation and demolitions.
- Jackhammering, erecting, digging, shoveling dirt, sweeping and debris clean up.
- Check the forms that hold the concrete to see that they are properly constructed.
- Set the forms that hold concrete to the desired pitch and depth and align them.
- Spread, level, and smooth concrete.
- Handle other physically demanding tasks.
- Could include other general labor tasks in a construction setting

- Experience with operating skid steers, mini excavators, utility tractors and backhoes.
